

SCHEMES FOR WOMEN

1). **Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Scheme:** Its objective is to prevent gender-biased sex selective elimination, ensure survival & protection of girl child and ensuring education and participation of the girl child.

2). **One-Stop Centre Scheme:** It is intended to support women affected by violence, in private and public spaces within the family, community, and at the workplace. Women facing physical, sexual, emotional, psychological economic abuse, irrespective of age, class, caste, education status, marital status, race, and culture will be facilitated with support and redressal.

3). **Women Helpline Scheme:** The scheme of universalization of women helpline is intended to provide 24 hours immediate and emergency response to women affected by violence through referral (linking with appropriate authority such as police, hospital) and information about women related government schemes, programs across the country through a single uniform number. Eligibility – Any needy women.

4). **UJJAWALA:** A Comprehensive Scheme for Prevention of trafficking and Rescue, Rehabilitation and Re-integration of Victims of Trafficking and Rescue, Rehabilitation and Re-integration of Victims of Trafficking and Commercial Sexual Exploitation.

5). **Working Women Hostel:** This scheme is to promote the availability of safe and conveniently located accommodation for working women, with daycare facilities for their children, wherever possible, in urban, semi-urban, or even rural areas where employment opportunities for women exist.

6). Ministry approves new projects under Ujjawala Scheme and continues existing projects.

7). **SWADHAR GREH:** A scheme for women in difficult circumstances. Its objective is to cater to the primary need of shelter, food, clothing, medical treatment, and care of women in distress and those who are without any social and economic support. Swadhar Greh will be set up in every district with a capacity of 30 women.

8). **NARI SHAKTI PURASKAR:** Nari Shakti Puraskar is an annual award given by the Ministry of Women and Child Development of the Government of India in recognition of exceptional work for women empowerment.

9). **Awardees of Stree Shakti Puruskar, 2014 & Awardees of Nari Shakti Puruskar.**

10). Awardees of Rajya Mahila Samman & Zila Mahila Samman.

11). **Mahila Police Volunteers:** An MPVs serve as a public–police interface to fight crime against women. The board mandate of MPVs is to report incidences of violence against women such as domestic violence, child marriage, dowry harassment, and violence faced by women in public spaces. She will act as a role model for the community.

12). **Mahila Shakti Kendras (MSK):** It has a view to creating an environment in which women realize their full potential, convergent support is being proposed for equal access to healthcare, quality education, career and vocational guidance, employment, health and safety, social security and digital literacy at gram panchayats level in selected districts across the country.

13). **NIRBHAYA:** Nirbhaya fund framework provides for non-lapsable corpus fund for safety and security of women administered by Department of Economic Affairs of the Ministry of Finance of the Government of India.

14). **The Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005:** A civil law meant for providing various reliefs to women facing domestic violence. Eligibility - Any women.
